Introduction



International Festival "Online Sound Resonances" 2020 was created at the request of young musicians eager to perform the works they have prepared during this isolation period. The organizer gives them the opportunity to be creative, motivated, appreciated, promoted and known at national and international levels.

The International Festival "Online Sound Resonances" is a cultural-artistic event, a competition-festival of vocal and instrumental musical interpretation, which aims to discover new young talents, to promote and to encourage young musicians, to become a preamble for their future artistic career, to highlight the importance of encouraging the future of the cultural world.

We consider that it's necessary to support young talents by motivating them to participate in competitions.

The Cultural Association "Sound Art" wants to support young performers in terms of the competition activity, which is indispensable in the atypical education process, as well as in the development of their artistic personality during this particularly difficult period.

Prof. Doina Saliu – President of the Cultural Association "Arta sonoră", together with the expert jury consisting of the teachers invited to hold the masterclasses of the International Cultural Festival "Sound Art" want to support these artists in development. They intend to give the participants the chance to get over this tough period more easily, because music is an occasion for joy and celebration.

The second, the 3rd and the 4th editions of **The International Festival "Online Sound Resonances" 2020 and 2022** were organized at the request of young interprets who participated in the first edition in mai 2020. The 5th edition of the **International Festival-Competition "Online Sound Resonances" 2022** took place between 9-11 of December 2022.

The 6th edition will take place between 8-10th of December 2023, organized at the request of young performers, in the online version, for all those who do not have the opportunity to participate physically, in Romania and worldwide.

Judging criteria

In evaluating competitors, the jury will take into account the following criteria:

Instrumental music:

- Respect for the score;
- Instrumental technique;
- Accuracy;
- Interpretation according to style;
- Stage posture;
- Appropriate choice depending on the level of preparation of the participant.

Vocal music:

- Correct intonation;
- Diction, rhythm, voice broadcast;
- Vocal technique;
- Expressiveness;
- Stage movement;
- Appropriate choice of the piece according to the level of preparation of the participant.

Participants will be graded as follows:

- 100 points First Prize for Excellence
- 95- 99 points First Prize
- 90- 94 points Second Prize
- 85-89 points Third Prize
- 80- 84 points Mention

At the decision of the jury, the participants who will have 100 points can benefit from the special prizes.

Special Award "Doctor of Violins" - Violin Masterclass by Prof. Florin Negreanu, 3 courses worth € 600.

"Sound Resonances on Festival Harmonies".

At the decision of the jury, certain participants with special prizes will receive a **10% discount for masterclass courses** within the International Cultural Festival "Sound Art", which will take place between 21-28 July 2023 and **recordings at Nak Music Studio with discount 20 %**



Participation Rules

I. General Conditions

- **1.1** Participants at the competition-festival are required to obey the terms and conditions of this Regulations of the International Festival-Competition "Online Sound Resonances" 2023-6th Edition, Piano-professionals, Amateur Piano/Secondary Instrument/ Private System, Classical Canto professionals, Violin, Viola, Flute, Percussion.
- **12** The regulations of the competition are made and published according to the Romanian Law.

II. Conditions to Participate

2.1 It is forbidden for the contestants to send recordings for which they do not hold copyrights according to Law 8/1996 with subsequent amendments and completions regarding copyright and related rights. In this regard, participants are responsible for the authenticity and originality of the recording.

This competition-festival is open to individuals of Romanian or foreign citizenship, regardless of nationality, who meet all the conditions provided by these regulations for the organization and conduct of the International Festival "Online Sound Resonances" 2023 – 6th Edition.

2.2 The Organizer will not consider recordings that violate in any way the Copyright Law or any other Romanian laws.

The recordings sent under the conditions of the present regulation of organization and development of the International Festival-Competition "Online Sound Resonances" 2023 - 6th Edition will be added as a **Youtube** link in the Registration Form -

https://forms.gle/S5EhMDVwn1nBkRzx5 completed with diacritics and carefully checked before sending. The text filled in by you in the form will appear on the diploma. By completing it, the contestant / guardian acknowledges and agrees with the Publication Agreement and the Parental Agreement to participate in the contest for minor participants.

- **2.3** Participants will send the recordings under the conditions of the Publication Agreement. Playback in any form is prohibited; it will result in disqualification from the competition. It is forbidden to master the performed pieces in the studio; this entails the disqualification from the competition.
- **2.4** Participants must pay the participation donation before 30th of November, 2023. The donation is not returned in case of withdrawal or elimination for any of the reasons invoked by the competitor.

The registration will be completed only after the registration form is sent, enclosing in the online form https://forms.gle/S5EhMDVwn1nBkRzx5 the proof of payment of the participation donation until 30th of November 2023.

2.5 The participation donation will be paid by bank transfer to the **account of the Cultural Association "Arta sonoră"**, opened at "**Banca Transilvania**", with IBAN: RO52 BTRL RONC RT05 2988 4501. The payment details will specify the name, surname of the participant, section and category where he or she participates.



III. Technical Details

- **3.1** The recordings must be clear, without disturbance or background noise. The camera must be positioned so that the whole body of the performer and the instrument are visible. Filming must be done in landscape format.
- **3.2** The accompaniment can be provided live or digitally. **Warning!** Make sure you have the consent of the accompanying teacher to appear on the recording.
- **3.3** All tracks must be included in a single recording. During the recording, the participant must specify the name, age and section in which he or she participates (and the name of the coteacher, where applicable)

IV. Final Results

- **4.1** Final results will be published on the association's website <u>artasonora.ro/rezonante-online</u> and on the facebook page <u>facebook.com/ac.artasonora</u> on 10 of December 2023.
- 4.2 The decisions of the jury are final and indisputable.

Make sure you have the consent of the accompanying teacher, where appropriate.

The video of the participant's performance will be uploaded as "Public" to the **YouTube** platform (see also *Video Upload Guide*). If a participant has chosen 2 works, they must be contained in the same video. **WARNING:** Make sure you have your accompanying teacher's consent, in case you are sending an accompanied performance.



During the recording, the participants must specify their name, age and section for which they participate. We recommend special attention to sound quality.

Filming must be done under special recording conditions, without disturbance, background noises, etc.

The camera should be placed in such a way that the whole body of the interpreter (and, as the case may be, the instrument) is visible.

The recordings with the performances will be broadcasted on the YouTube channel "Arta sonoră", according to the Deployment calendar, in ascending order of age in each section.

The most highly appreciated works will be proposed by the section's expert jury to be awarded.

The winners of the special awards will be invited to participate in the recitals organized by the Cultural Association "Arta sonoră".

2. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

4. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SUPPLIER

The supplier will provide online access to the Work, but does not offer any guarantee regarding the benefits or services it provides to the Author of the Work or regarding the performance, functionality, quality or availability of publishing platforms or applications.



5. COMPENSATIONS




Posting using computer

 - 3. Press the "Create a video or post" button, and then select "Upload video"






4. Press the "Select Files" button




5. Browse and select the video






6. Be sure to include your name and the festival's name in the title




7. Select the "Yes, it's Made for Kids" option, and then press "Next"






8. Press the "Next" button








10. At this point the link to the video is saved to the "clipboard". Press the "Close" button to close the processing window (processing will continue in the background).




